The continuous creative collaboration between Cherevichkiotvichki and Yohji Yamamoto sets course into the Spring-Summer 2017 Femme collection.

In coherence with Yohji Yamamoto's Spring 2017 show, Victoria Andrejeva of Cherevichkiotvichki presented two solid styles to the collection.

The first style being a classic boot made of black leather with a Victoria's typical waxed finish. The notable feature being two zippers running down both sides of the boot, and yet the model being made of just one piece of leather. The second style - a classic derby shoe with hand-dyed linen laces.

The striking elements of these styles mixed with the classic touch of Italian artisanal shoe making on the Blake stitched construction is a common theme within Cherevichkiotvichki. The material and methods may be traditional, but the pattern cutting and finish are a unique touch of Andrejeva. These footwear making methods alongside the Yamamoto's Spring 2017 Femme collection complete with garments covered in paint strokes and distorted asymmetric jackets, create a harmony that is only understood once combined.

The collaboration pieces will be exclusively available in the Yohji Yamamoto stores and selected boutiques worldwide in early 2017.



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
