The collaboration between Vicotria Andrejeva of Cherevichkiotvichki and the Japanese house Yohji Yamamoto continues for the Spring Summer 2019 Femme collection.

This season's 'relaxed elegance' and structural comfort were the main drive for Andrejeva's designs. Looking into ancient ceremonial dressing and the footwear that would accompany these puritanical garments. A sense of ease being a reoccurring theme echoing through comfort within the footwear. The four designs Andrejeva presented are both soft and subtle but with the Cherevichkiotvichki raw artisanal touch, especially when it comes to leather treatment.

The first design - a shoes-sandal with a toe post. Combining both these stylistic elements creates an obvious ease juxtaposed with a sliced leather material. The second design being a sandal boot that works its way above the ankle with an open toe cut. The boot then wraps around the ankle in a soft natural way like a robe. The material used is a woven leather, raw and textural, referencing an ancient time period but with minimal contemporary approach to pattern cutting. The other two models are asymmetric, they follow unusual lines and cuts creating airy pockets to celebrate the lightness of this Spring collection.

The collaboration pieces will be exclusively available in the Yohji Yamamoto stores and selected boutiques worldwide in early 2019.



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
