"The Maker's Arms" is an anthem embodied in a physical form. A postcard from the very first collection created by Victoria Andrejeva. The first of 10 unique anniversary lots to be auctioned off over the coming months.

The process had started as an exact chiselled replica of Andrejeva's arms. The leather, found in the studio, then moulded over the cast and stitched following joint lines and veins. The found bicycle chain is holding the pair together strong, as a serpent of wisdom signifying the presence of mind and its mechanical processes.

The hands have a relaxed pose with fingers spread in a natural asymmetrical way, as if frozen in anticipation of starting a new piece.

This infinite process that inevitably manifests the relationship between the physical and the spiritual worlds of a human life. Our mind and our body. A connecting bicycle chain is a symbol of mechanical friction that spurs an inevitable progress.
