The continued collaboration between the Japanese house and Cherevichkiotvichki's London and Italian based artisanal studios, "Cherevichkiotvichki for Yohji Yamamoto", progresses into its 6th men's footwear season. For the AW19 Homme collection, Victoria Andrejeva of Cherevichkiotvichki continues to explore her passion for artisanal craft-heritage, present in both her and Yohji Yamamoto's creations.

The tradition of old Italian craftsmanship and resourceful creation forms a benchmark for all Cherevichkiotvichki collections, where every piece is hand-made using a unique Blake construction on a Goodyear insole. The two styles of shoe created for this season's collaboration incorporate a left-over wool textile from the Yohji Yamamoto's previous collections into the upper, which when laced, creates a generous and relaxed volume in the waxed calfskin boot made entirely out of one piece, complementing the tapered drapery of the trousers. Furthermore, the presence of wool creates a tactile and textural thread between the shoes and the collection itself.

The collaboration pieces will be exclusively available in the Yohji Yamamoto stores and selected boutiques worldwide in the Summer 2019.



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
