"Entering into a collaborative relationship with Yohji Yamamoto has been an honour and a pleasure on the creative journey of my career.

I believe that preserving singular identity is the only personal and unique element that I can deliver as an artist and a designer, however, I have found great inspiration in Yamamoto-San's technique and the fruit of his house. Since 2016 each footwear design for Yohji Yamamoto has been a free-flow of functional ideas; a meeting point with a single goal - to complete the moment when one's foot touches the ground beneath it.

For their Spring Summer 2021 Femme collection we have created two styles of deconstructed shoes fueled by the quote from late Leonard Cohen - "there is a crack in everything, that's how the light gets in". One style is made of just two pieces of leather delicately held together by a strong thread that we use for stitching soles. And the other - is a boot sandal with a big hole, to let that light in. As always, I have kept to the tradition of artisanal shoe-making which forms the foundation of all Cherevichkiotvichki collections."
