Cherevichkiotvichki brings the creative collaboration with Yohji Yamamoto to a whole new level season after season, consolidating a reputation of ever inspired experimentation, while remaining steadily grounded on the artisanal techniques and traditional craftsmanship that distinguishes the fashion house.

For the SS22 HOMME collaboration, Victoria Andrejeva of Cherevichkiotvichki explores antique references, with a footwear that looks at the past with fresh eyes. The Double-Cap Toe Derby is an unusual twist on a derby style, with two caps overlaying each other, one of the two unstitched from the upper part. The design conveys the warm, handmade feeling that is one of Cherevichkiotvichki trademarks. The aged leather sole is a tribute to the ancient times that inspired this model. The raw cut of the cap creates a movement on the surface, and the slightly asymmetric lines gives the shoe a dynamic twist, highlighting the handicraft process that characterises the work of the brand since its beginnings.

The material is a structured yet light matt waxed calf leather, which gives the derby a classic look and an elegant appearance, balancing the antique reference with a contemporary, timeless appeal.



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
